OUR FUTURE

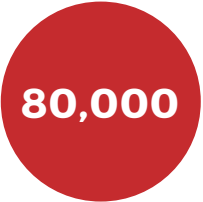

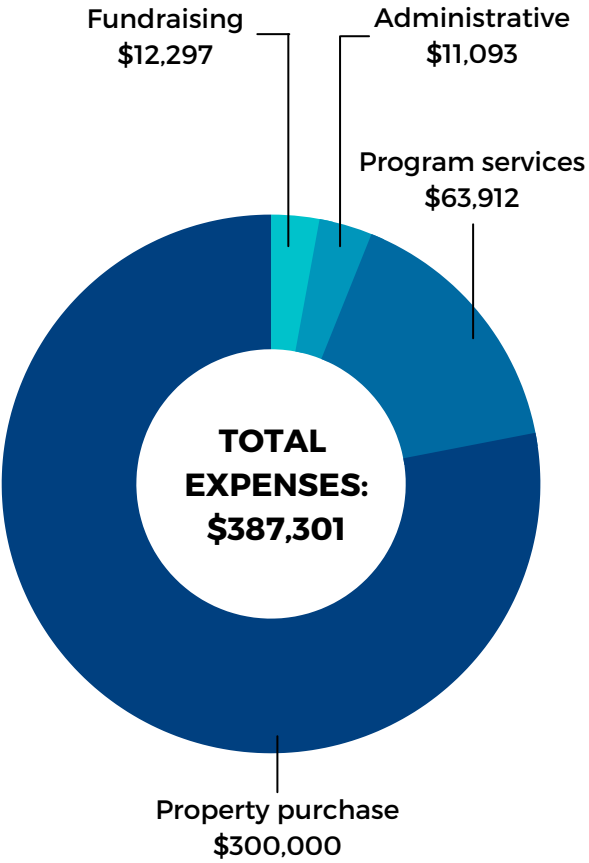
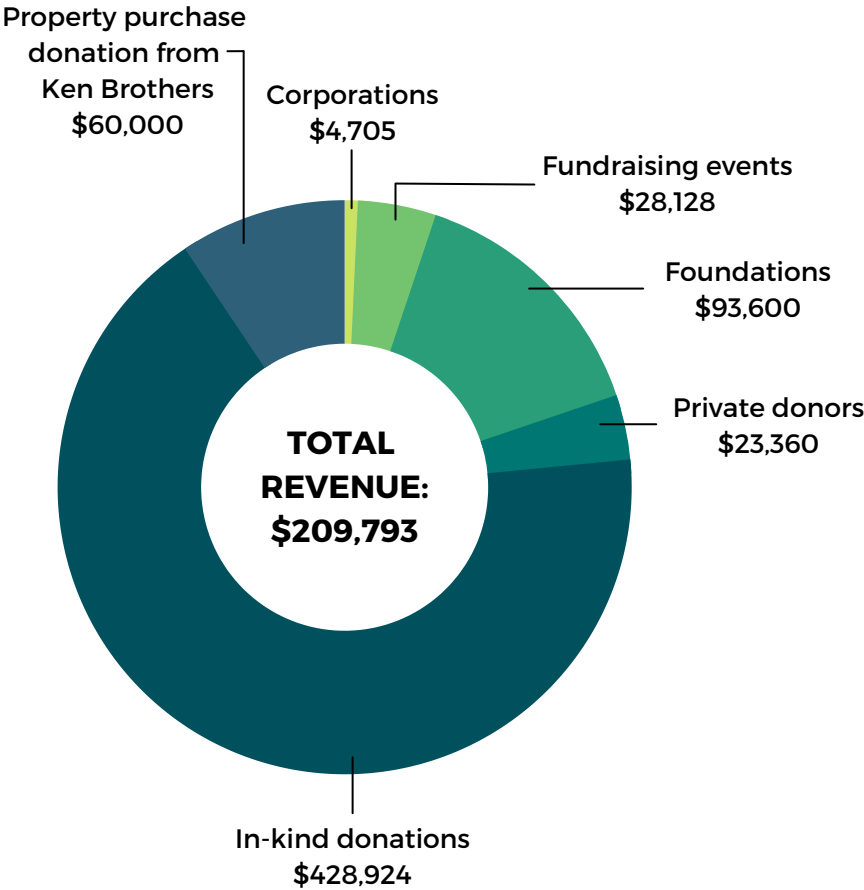

MARCH

Returned to in-person care at the Ogden Rescue Mission.

OUR HISTORY

In 1988, Dr. Floyd Seager, a local physician, saw a man collapse on the street in Ogden and went to his aid. He learned that the man was homeless and didn't have any access to medical care. Dr. Seager had to do something, so he and his wife, Dauna, founded the clinic in partnership with the Ogden Rescue Mission on September 16, 1988.

The Seagers have since passed away, but their legacy lives on, with over 170 volunteers involved in the Seager Memorial Clinic as of 2021. Top professionals in the area provide volunteer medical and dental care, and the entire Board of Directors and all officers of the clinic are volunteer positions. We have two part-time paid employees.

We are fortunate to have developed strong partnerships with Intermountain Healthcare, Ogden Regional Medical Center, Ogden Rescue Mission, Treeo Senior Living, Weber Human Services, and several other community organizations.
